

IBEW-ATC Substation Construction Safety Liaison

American Transmission Company, IBEW locals 2150/953/876, MJ Electric, and MP Systems are looking for an additional Construction Management field safety liaison position.

The safety liaison will:

- Hold a journey level substation technician certification and have significant utility substation construction experience with a reputation for working safely.
- Spend the majority of work time visiting substation construction crews advocating for the safety of construction workers throughout the ATC footprint in Wisconsin and Michigan.
- Be in the bargaining unit classified as a Foreman while in the position.
- Report directly to an IBEW Business Manager and ATC Prevention & Response Manager.
- Report information in a way that will honor contractor confidentiality and will not implicate individuals or groups of individuals with respect to safety concerns. Reported information will not be used for punitive or disciplinary purposes except certain critical rules will be discussed directly between ATC and the applicable local union and contractor.
